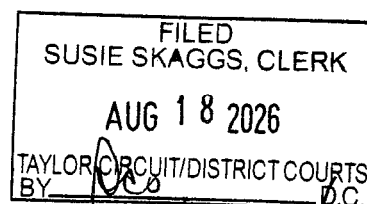

Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about June 20, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant appears in a public place manifestly under the influence of a controlled substance, or other intoxicating substance, excluding alcohol (unless the alcohol is present in combination with any of the above), not therapeutically administered, to the degree that he may endanger himself or other persons or property, or unreasonably annoy person in his vicinity or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

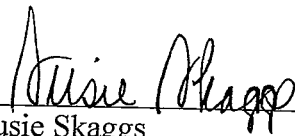

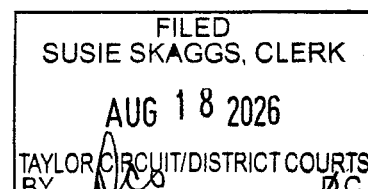

The Grand Jury charges that on or about July 18, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant was operating a motor vehicle anywhere in this state: having an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the influence of alcohol; while under the influence of any other substance or combination of substances which impairs one's driving ability; while the presence of a controlled substance listed in subsection (12) of this section is detected in the blood, as measured by a scientifically reliable test, or tests, taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical control of a motor vehicle; while under the combined influence of alcohol and any other substance which impairs one's driving ability; or having an alcohol concentration of 0.02 or more as measured by a scientifically reliable test or tests of a sample of the person's breath or blood taken within two (2) hours of cessation of operation or physical



control of a motor vehicle, if the person is under the age of twenty-one (21) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about July 18, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant has in his or her possession an open alcoholic beverage container in the passenger area of a motor vehicle located on a public highway or on the right-of-way of a public highway or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 18, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant failed to produce written proof in the form of an insurance card that the insured has in effect an insurance contract providing security in conformity with this subtitle or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. 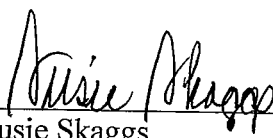

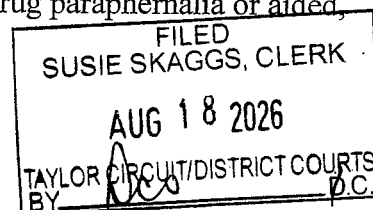

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about June 29, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully was trafficking in four (4) grams or more of cocaine; two (2) grams or more of methamphetamine; ten (10) or more dosage units of a controlled substance that is classified in schedules I or II and is a narcotic drug, or a controlled substance analogue; any quantity of heroin, **Fentanyl**, carfentanil, or fentanyl derivatives; lysergic acid diethylamide; phencyclidine; gamma hydroxybutyric acid (GHB), including its salts, isomers, salts of isomers and analogues; or flunitrazepam, including its salts, isomers and salts of isomers; or any quantity of a controlled substance specified in paragraph (a) (b), or (c) of this subsection in an amount less than the amounts specified in those paragraphs classified in Schedules I or II, a narcotic drug or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about June 29, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly and unlawfully possessed drug paraphernalia or aided,

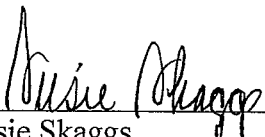

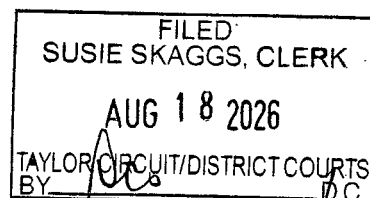

Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 2:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about December 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky the above-named defendant with the intent to cause the death of another person, cause the death of such person or of a third person 2.) and/or including but not limited to, the operation of a motor vehicle under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to human life, he/she wantonly engages in conduct which creates a grave risk of death to another person and thereby caused the death of another person or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 3:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about December 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, **by discharging a firearm**, under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he/she wantonly engages in conduct which creates a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person, or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about December 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, **by discharging a firearm**, under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he/she wantonly engages in conduct which creates a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person, or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about December 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant he or she with respect to any scheduled, publicly advertised event open to the public, any place of worship, any school function, any workplace, or any gathering of three (3) or more persons, threatens to commit by any means, including by use

of a firearm, any act likely to result in death or serious physical injury to any person. A threat directed at a person or persons at a scheduled, publicly advertised event open to the public, place of worship, school, workplace, or gathering of three (3) or more persons does not need to identify a specific person or persons or school in order for a violation of this section to occur; (b) Makes false statements by any means, including by electronic communication, indicating that an act likely to result in death or serious physical injury is occurring or will occur for the purpose of: 1. Causing evacuation of a school building, school property, or school sanctioned activity; 2. Causing cancellation of school classes or school-sanctioned activity; or 3. Creating fear of death or serious physical injury among students, parents, or school personnel; (c) Makes false statements that he or she has placed a weapon of mass destruction at any location other than one specified in KRS 508.075; or (d) Without lawful authority places a counterfeit weapon of mass destruction at any location other than one specified in KRS 508.075. (2) A counterfeit weapon of mass destruction is placed with lawful authority if it is placed as part of an official training exercise by a public servant, as defined in KRS 522.010. (3) A person is not guilty of commission of an offense under this section if he or she, innocently and believing the information to be true, communicates a threat made by another person to school personnel, a peace officer, a law enforcement agency, a public agency involved in emergency response, or a public safety answering point and identifies the person from whom the threat was communicated, if known. or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the people of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about December 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky the above-named defendant having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he has such right, he intentionally or wantonly defaces, destroys or damages any property causing pecuniary loss of \$1,000 or more or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about December 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent a peace officer, recognized to be acting under color of his official authority from effecting an arrest of the actor or another by: using or threatening to use physical force or violence against the peace officer or another; or using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to the peace office or another or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about December 14, 2024, in Taylor County, Kentucky the above-named defendant violated the condition of release by defining an order directing to vacate or stay away from the home of the alleged victim or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 9:

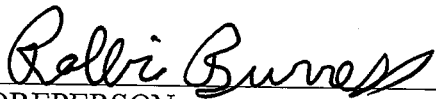

a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 7-8:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 26, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant unlawfully took or exercised control over movable property (valued over \$10,000.00) of another with intent to deprive him or her thereof; or obtains immovable property of another or any interest therein with intent to benefit himself or herself or another not entitled thereto or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 9:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 26, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant unlawfully took or exercised control over movable property (**Firearms**) of another with intent to deprive him thereof; or obtains immovable property of another or any interest therein with intent to benefit himself or another not entitled thereto or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 10-11:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 26, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky the above-named defendant having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he has such right, he intentionally or wantonly defaces, destroys or damages any property causing pecuniary loss of \$1,000 or more or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNTS 12-17:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 26, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant when under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, he/she wantonly engages in conduct which creates a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another person or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 18:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 26, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he or she has such right, he or she: intentionally or wantonly defaces, destroys, or damages any property causing pecuniary loss of less than five hundred dollars (\$500); or As a tenant, intentionally or wantonly defaces, destroys, or damages residential rental property causing pecuniary loss of less than five hundred dollars (\$500) or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 19:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 26, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally or wantonly causes physical injury to another person; or

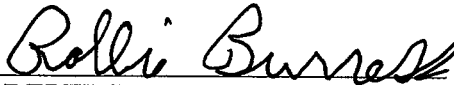
with recklessness he causes physical injury to another person by means of a deadly weapon or a dangerous instrument or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 20:

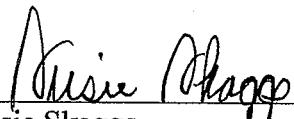
The Grand Jury charges: That on or about July 26, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant operator of any vehicle, whose vehicle, vehicle load or vehicle equipment which is involved in an accident resulting in injury to or death of any person or resulting only in damage to a vehicle or other property which is driven or attended by any person, shall immediately stop and ascertain the extent of the injury or damage and render reasonable assistance, including the carrying, or making of arrangements for the carrying of such person to a physician, surgeon, or hospital for medical or surgical treatment if it is apparent that such treatment is necessary, or if such carrying is requested by the injured person. The operator or person having or assuming authority of the operator, or ownership of the vehicle, shall give the occupant of the vehicle, or person struck, if requested, the registration number of the vehicle, if any, and also the names and addresses of the owner, the occupants and operator. The total names need not exceed five (5) in number or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
