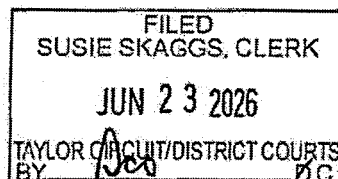

occurs while the healthcare provider is providing medical care in an emergency room of a hospital; paid or volunteer emergency medical services personnel certified or licensed pursuant to KRS Chapter 311A if the event occurs while personnel are performing job-related duties; a paid or volunteer member of an organized fire department, if the event occurs while the member is performing job-related duties; paid or volunteer rescue squad personnel affiliated with the Division of Emergency Management of the Department of Military Affairs or a local disaster and emergency services organization pursuant to KRS Chapter 39F, if the event occurs while personnel are performing job-related duties or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. (RS kicked) (GM & DG scratched)

COUNT 4:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 15, 2026, through April 16, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant threaten to commit any crime likely to result in death or serious physical injury to another person or likely to result in substantial property damage to another person; or intentionally makes false statements for the purpose of causing evacuation of a building, place of assembly, or facility of public transportation or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 5:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 15, 2026, through April 16, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent a peace officer, recognized to be acting under color of his official authority from effecting an arrest of the actor or another by: using or threatening to use physical force or violence against the peace officer or another; or using any other means creating a substantial risk of causing physical injury to the peace officer or another or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 6:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 15, 2026, through April 16, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant when he or she: in a public place and with intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance, or alarm, or wantonly creating a risk thereof: engages in fighting or in violent, tumultuous, or threatening behavior; make unreasonable noise; or refuses to obey an official order to disperse issued to maintain public safety in dangerous proximity to a fire, hazard, or other emergency; or creates a hazardous or physically offensive condition by any act that serves no legitimate purpose or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 7:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about April 15, 2026, through April 16, 2026, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant intentionally placed another person in reasonable apprehension of imminent physical injury or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

COUNT 8:

The Grand Jury charges that on or about the January 27, 2010, through January 26, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant, subjects another person, into sexual contact by forcible compulsion or he subjects another person to sexual contact who is incapable of consent because he or she is physically helpless; is less than twelve (12) years old or is mentally incapacitated; is an individual with an intellectual disability; or being twenty-one (21) years old or more, he or she: subjects another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old to sexual contact; engages in masturbation in the presence of another person who is less than sixteen (16) years old and knows or has reason to know the other person is present; or engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old, and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate; or being a person in a position of authority or position of special trust as defined in KRS 532.045, he or she, regardless of his or her age, subjects a minor who is less than eighteen (18) years old, with whom he or she comes into contact as a result of the position, to sexual contact or engages in masturbation in the presence of the minor and knows or has reason to know the minor is present or engages in masturbation while using the internet, telephone, or other electronic communication device while communicating with a minor who the person knows is less than sixteen (16) years old, and the minor can see or hear the person masturbate aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. **(Barbie)**

COUNTS 11-13:

The Grand Jury charges: That on or about January 27, 2010, through January 26, 2018, in Taylor County, Kentucky, the above-named defendant knowingly induces, assists or causes a minor to engage in illegal controlled substances activity involving marijuana, illegal gambling activity, or any other criminal activity constituting a felony or aided, abetted or counseled with another in said act. Said act was against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
